## Sacred Hearts Retreat/ Spirituality Center

### Who We Are

The Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary purchased the beautiful Herrick estate in 1943 for a Seminary. Years later it was transformed into a retreat center.

For nearly 40 years, thousands of people have called Sacred Hearts Retreat/Spirituality Center a home away from home. Still today, visitors find attractive the hospitality, the setting of the 100 year old manor house, and the 118 acres of forest and waterfront on Cape Cod.

Sacred Hearts is a place where people of all faiths, denominations and perspectives find the peace, serenity, and healing for which they so desperately seek.

The center can accommodate 52 overnight guests in 24 private and semi-private rooms in the main house and 9 in four bedrooms in the cottage. The youth center sleeps 41 students in 2 dormitories of bunk beds. Retreatants enjoy excellent food and dining, walking trails, meditation garden, stations of the cross, labyrinth, wildlife, ocean breezes and a private beach.

### What We Do

A wide range of retreats, workshops, conferences and other activities are offered during the week and on weekends year round. These include recovery weekends, parish groups, college groups, half-day mini retreats, prayer and reflection groups, and craft groups including knitters and weavers etc.

Day and overnight youth programs for junior high, high schools, confirmation groups, etc. are accommodated in the youth center.
